Ministerial Failure

• 63% of educators report their ministries of education are "not supportive at all".



Poor Working Conditions

- Nearly 80% of educators report struggling to cope.
- 95% of educators are concerned that staff shortages are negatively impacting students.

Overloaded and Complex Classrooms

- 77% of educators report that students' needs have become "significantly more complex" compared to five years ago.
- Factors include: number of high-needs students, diversity of needs, lack of support personnel.



Rising Violence and Aggression

- 55% of educators have experienced violence or aggression in the past year.
- Of reported incidents, only 25% indicated that appropriate actions were taken by health and safety committees.



Overwork and Insufficient Prep Time

- 73% of educators work more than 45 hours per week; 35% exceed 48 hours.
- 65% of educators identify more prep time as a top priority for improving working conditions.

Educators' Recommendations to Improve Working Conditions

- Class Size Reductions: Supported by 75% of educators.
- Increased Support Staff: Supported by 71% of educators.
- Class Complexity Provisions: Supported by 66% of educators.
- Dedicated Preparation Time: Supported by 65% of educators.
